

## Local rules for this competition

1. This competition is held under the general rules of WPBSA and BSAACT competition rules. Where there is any inconsistency between the WPBSA, BSAACT, or these local rules, the local rules are to be used.
2. Start time is 7:30pm, or by mutual agreement of both teams.
3. Format is best of 5 frames. One point is scored per match won.
  - a. Ranking will be on matches won, followed by frames won.
4. All players are required to attend the pre-comp meeting held on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> of July, 7:30pm at SX Woden**. Players score one point for attendance.
5. This is a 16 week competition. Each player plays each other twice, followed by a knockout semi-final and final.
6. This is an A-Grade competition. All players start off scratch.
7. Where a player is unable to attend a match, the match may be rescheduled (let the comp director know), or alternatively the reserve player may be contacted for play.
8. If three or more snookers are required and only colours remain, the frame ends at the conclusion of the current break. For the avoidance of doubt, this means that the frame ends if the difference in scores is at least:
  - a. Yellow ball on: 36 points
  - b. Green ball on: 34 points
  - c. Brown ball on: 31 points
  - d. Blue ball on: 29 points
  - e. Pink ball on: 26 points
9. The following advice is given on the foul and a miss rule. The WPBSA rule 3.14 (a) states that player shall to the best of their ability endeavour to hit a ball on:
  - i - For A grade players, if a one-cushion escape is available from a snooker, then a foul and a miss should be called.
